LABOUR PLANS TO CLOSE UXBRIDGE POLICE STATION

■ Labour's Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, has published proposals to close Uxbridge Police Station permanently and sell the land for development.

The consultation is part of the Public Access and Engagement Strategy which sets out changes to front counters across London.

The proposal is to close the 24/7 front counter at Uxbridge Station and dispose of the Uxbridge Police Station along with Ruislip and Northwood Police offices over the next 3-5 years.

Your local Conservative team oppose Labour's proposal to close Uxbridge Police station and believe it is vital for this resource to continue in our main town centre.
